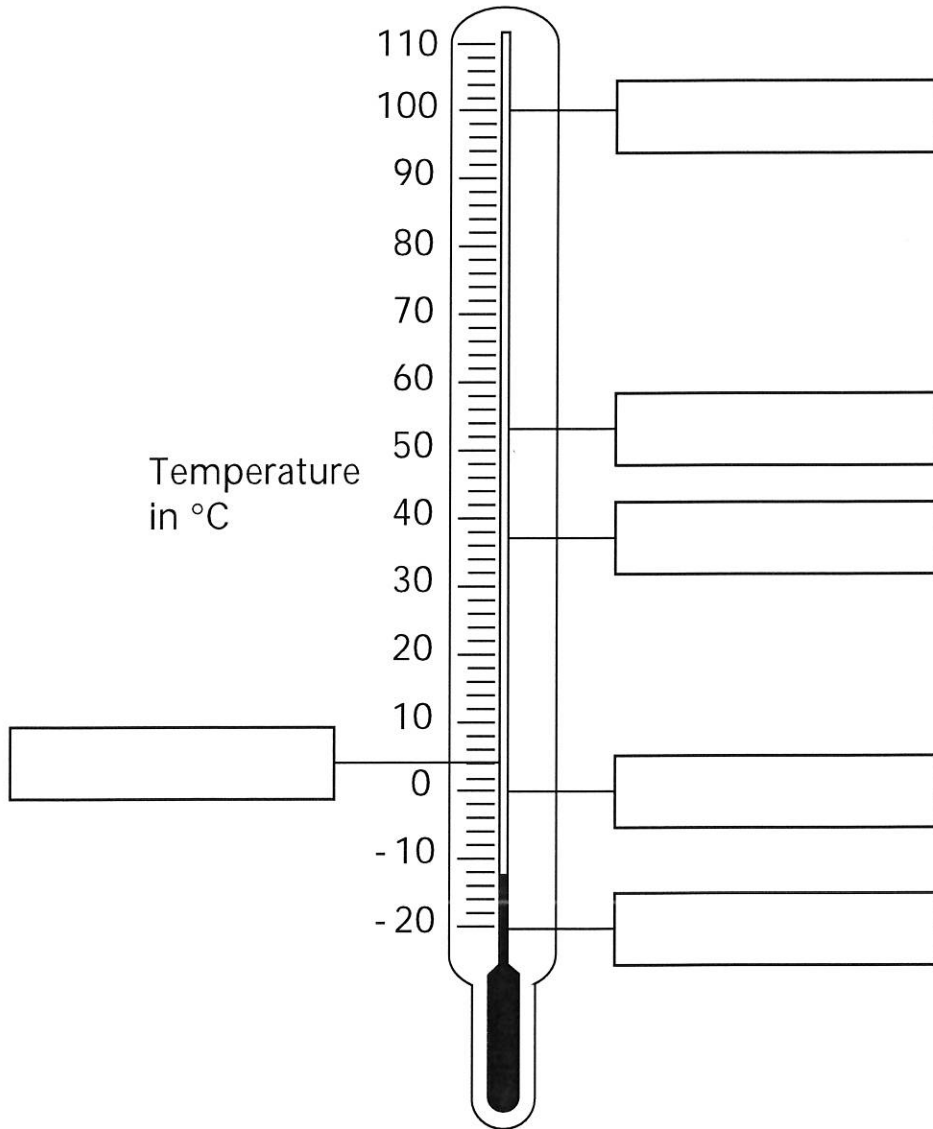




3 Look at this drawing of a thermometer.

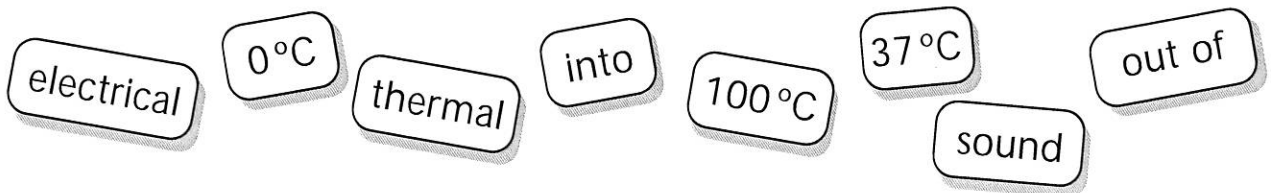
